

## **RESOLUTION 1**

**WHEREAS** Kansas Day, January 29, is an annual celebration of Kansas' entry as a state into the Union.

**WHEREAS** Kansas Day is the traditional weekend for the Kansas Republican Party's State Committee meeting and a gathering of Kansas Republicans and a variety of Republican organizations

**WHEREAS** the Kansas Day weekend should be treated as the Kansas Republican Party convention with all scheduling, fundraising, and activities to benefit the mission of the Kansas Republican Party; to help elect Republicans.

1. Each year, the Kansas Republican Party shall hold its Kansas Day Convention in a different Congressional District.
